Do you want to work outdoors? Do you like the water, helping our environment, and community? If you answered yes, a job as a River Ambassador might be right for you!

Enderby & District Recreation Services Association is looking for River Ambassadors for the 2022 Summer season. We are looking for friendly, outgoing individuals who have excellent interpersonal and communication skills. The right candidates will have a passion for the environment and be comfortable in and around the water.

This position requires you to be cross trained to work both as a Visitor Information Councilor and a River Ambassador. The rate of pay will be \$16.00 per hour for 35 hours per week starting the end of June until beginning of September.

Eligibility criteria for applicants:

- 15-30 years of age
- Be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident of Canada, or have been granted refugee status in Canada (foreign students are non-eligible)
- Class 7 License and a reliable vehicle is an asset
- Flexible hours (weekends, evenings, holidays and community events)
- A good team worker, responsible and can work well unsupervised
- Experience on paddle board or kayak an asset
- Knowledge of the Shuswap River and River/Water Safety
- Community and Regional knowledge

Duties include but are not limited to:

Educating tourists and locals about the community/region, Shuswap River, float times, and safety on the River in a professional and friendly manner.

Attending events representing and promoting Shuswap River Ambassador Program

Recording river usage data, creating informative videos, managing social media posts, creating brochures/flyers

Paddling the Shuswap River on a stand up paddle board cleaning the banks and bed of the river, recording float/paddle times.

Assisting with other community organizations and events, setting up and performing safety demos and information booths.

Keeping work spaces in a clean manor including public washrooms, the building exterior, and stocking products
